Training Mandates due by 08/31/2025

Individuals not appointed with a department must go thru one of our Training Providers to complete the required training listed above. TCOLE will not accept training that is not thru one of our providers.

Licensed Peace Officers (includes County Sheriffs and Deputy Constables):

Current 2-year Training Unit: (09/01/23 - 08/31/25):

A minimum of 40 hours of training to include the current Legislative Update course #3188, 16 hours of ALERRT training*, Finding Wellness - Building a Healthier Life (#4202), Trauma-Informed Approach to Sexual Assault Investigations (#470 or #4070)**

*The following course numbers count towards the ALERRT training mandate: #3381, #3380, #3376, #3377, #3394, #3393, #3317, #3318, #3311, #3382, #3392, #3312, #3315, #3605, #3606, #3355, #78052, #667371.

**If not completed in the 09/01/2021-08/31/2023 unit.

Current 4-year Training Cycle: (09/01/21 - 08/31/25):

Licensed Peace Officers without Intermediate (or higher) Proficiency Certification must complete: Cultural Diversity (#3939 or #394), Crisis Intervention (#3843 or #1850), Special Investigative Topics (#3232), De-escalation (#1849).

Additional mandated courses:

Peace Officers first licensed on or after 01/01/2011: Human Trafficking (#3270) within 2 years of initial licensing date – unless the course was included in BPOC.

Peace Officers first licensed on or after 01/01/2016: Canine Encounters (#4065) within 2 years of initial licensing date – unless the course was included in BPOC.

Peace Officers first licensed on or after 03/01/2016: Interacting with Deaf and Hard of Hearing Drivers (#7887) within 2 years of licensing date – unless the course was included in BPOC.

Peace Officers first licensed on or after 04/01/2018: 40-hr CIT (#1850) within 2 years of licensing date – unless course was included in BPOC.

Peace Officers licensed PRIOR to 01/01/2018: Civilian Interaction Training Program (#30418) by 01/01/2020. All others within 2 years of initial licensing date – unless course was included in BPOC.

Constables and Deputy Constables:

Constables:

- ☐ New Constable Training (#3742) thru LEMIT within 2 years of being appointed/elected.
- ☐ Continuing Education (#3743) thru LEMIT each 4-year training cycle thereafter.
- ☐ Civil Process (#1415) exclusively thru Texas Justice Court Training Center (TJCTC) at Texas State University each 4-yr training cycle.
- ☐ 16 hours of ALERRT training every 2-year unit

*This mandate overrides the afore mentioned Unit and Cycle requirements, but not the "Additional Mandated Courses".

Deputy Constables:

In addition to the afore mentioned "Licensed Peace Officer" requirements, the Civil Process course (#3131) must be completed each 4-yr training cycle.

Police Chiefs:

- ☐ Must take 80 hours of New Chief's Training - New Chief Development Program (TCOLE 3780) AND Texas Police Chief Leadership Series (TCOLE 3740) - within 2 years of first appointment as Texas Chief of Police.
- ☐ Must take Chief's Continuing Education - Texas Police Chief LEadership Series (TCOLE 3740) - each Unit, thereafter. Course #3740 will contain 8 hours of ALERRT training, however, an additional 8 hours of ALERRT training must be obtained.

*This mandate overrides the aforementioned Peace Officer Unit and Cycle requirements, but not the "Additional Mandated Courses".

County Jailers:

Cultural Diversity course (#3939 or #394) every 4-yr training cycle by 08/31/2025. If you have an active Peace Officer license **and** a Peace Officer Intermediate Proficiency Certificate or higher, you do not need to complete Cultural Diversity.

Telecommunicators:

Current 2-year Training Unit: (09/01/23 - 08/31/25):

- ☐ A minimum of 20 hours of training to include Cardiac Emergency Communications (#786)*.

*A current, nationally recognized CPR certification is required in order to enroll.

- Crisis Intervention Training (#3843 or #1850)
- Cultural Diversity (#3939 or #394)
- De-escalation Techniques (#1849)
- Special Investigative Topics (#3232)

2-year Training Unit: (9/1/23-8/31/25):

☐ A minimum of 40 hours of training to include:

- Legislative Update course (#3188)
- 16 hours of ALERRT training*
- Finding Wellness – Building a Healthier Life (course #4202) in-person or on MyTCOLE 3.0.
- Trauma-Informed Approach to Sexual Assault Investigations (MyTCOLE 3.0 online course #470 or in-person training course #4070), if not completed in the 9/1/21-8/31/23 unit. An equivalent to this course will be #3264 – Special Investigator Certification.

Deputy Constables:

☐ In addition to the aforementioned “Licensed Peace Officer” requirements, Civil Process (#3131) must be completed in the 4-year training cycle.

*A note on ALERRT training:

The passage of Senate Bill 1852 requires **all peace officers to attend ALERRT Level 1 training at least once** prior to 8/31/2027. Courses which will satisfy this requirement include #3311, #3313, and train-the-trainer #3315. This new law also requires that every peace officer complete 16 hours of ALERRT training every two-year unit going forward.

Peace officers who have previously completed course #3311, #3313, or #3315 and have at least one of these courses documented on their TCOLE training record do not need to repeat ALERRT Level 1 training; however, they must take at least 16 hours of ALERRT training during this 2-year training unit before 8/31/2025. Courses which will satisfy the 16-hour requirement are included in the approved list below. (*Continued on next page*)

Peace officers who do NOT have course #3311, #3313, or #3315 documented on their TCOLE training record are encouraged to complete course #3311 during this current training unit prior to 8/31/2025 as their 16-hour continuing education requirement if at all possible. If not completed during this training unit, they MUST have completed #3311 prior to 8/31/2027 in accordance with Senate Bill 1852.
